Australian Applicants

We welcome applications from enrolled and registered nurses who are approaching graduation or recently graduated. Before you can commence work, and therefore your graduate program, you will require registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia. You can find out more about the registration process at www.ahpra.gov.au

International Applicants

We accept applications from recently graduated international registered nurses. If applying from overseas, you will still need to meet the criteria for registration as a Registered Nurse /Registered Midwife with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia. There are Registration Standards for nurses and midwives that can be very important to international graduates in relation to English language requirements The Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia website provides this information.

How to apply

There are two main intakes per year - February and mid-year.

All applications are processed electronically and can be accessed via the link "APPLY" at the bottom of this page.

This usually requires;

- Letter of application including rationale for applying to Healthscope Eastern Network of Hospitals Graduate Nurse Program and outlining areas of clinical interest
- Current CV
- Certified copy of academic transcript
- Two certified clinical reports from recent acute clinical placements
- Two clinical referees
- One passport sized photo
